From daycare centers, food cupboards, and advocacy rights groups; to hospitals, educational institutions and faith based organizations, the charitable or nonprofit sector in the United States comprises a diverse set of organizations who exist to serve and promote the common good. Throughout all corners of the U.S. you will find committed individuals coming together to make their communities stronger and better for all.

Generally, most nonprofit organizations are best known by the services they provide to people in need. It is important to remember that these agencies also create the space and opportunity for individuals to engage in volunteerism and become actively involved in civic life. By connecting people, inspiring altruism, and giving voice to local and far-reaching concerns, charities weave an uninterrupted web of connection that binds communities together.

Most registered charitable nonprofit agencies are small in size and volunteer led. From local PTA groups to youth sports leagues, these organizations are at work everyday.

FAST FACTS

- * There were a total of 837,027 charitable nonprofits in the United States, excluding foundation and religious congregations.
- * More than two in three nonprofits have assets of less than \$25,000.
- * 288,150 charitable nonprofits had gross receipts of over \$25,000 in 2003 and filed IRS Form 990. These organizations are often referred to as "reporting" nonprofits.
- * Total assets of all reporting nonprofits were \$1.76 trillion.
- * Total expenditures of all reporting nonprofits were \$945 billion.
- * The 66,398 reporting foundations in the United States held almost \$477 billion in assets and distributed over \$30 billion in grants.
